**About the concert:** The *Turkey River Suite* is inspired by a family cabin in Northeast Iowa that sits on the bank of the Turkey River. The movements evoke the methodical churning of the water, surprisingly majestic bluffs and landscapes, as well as a final reminder of the animals and other humans with which we coexist. –Dan Padley

**Miera Kim, violinist,** is the Executive Director of Red Cedar Chamber Music. She grew up in Iowa City, IA as a



student of Doris Preucil at the Preucil School of Music. She furthered her studies with Jascha Brodsky at the Curtis Institute of Music and Allen Ohmes at the University of Iowa. She is a

sought-after clinician and private teacher, and has previously held titled chairs with Orchestra Iowa and the Quad City Symphony. Miera also serves as concertmaster of both the Iowa City Community String Orchestra and the Sinfonia Nolte Nutcracker orchestra. She plays a 1735 Nicolò Gagliano violin.

**Carey Bostian, cellist,** is the Artistic Director of Red Cedar Chamber Music.



He is also conductor of the Iowa City Community String Orchestra and former principal cellist of Orchestra Iowa. He has presented thousands of educational concerts for

students of all ages. Carey has a DMA in cello performance and an MFA in orchestral conducting from the Univ. of Iowa. He actively promotes new music and frequently performs music of local and regional composers. He began performing with RCCM in 2006. Carey plays a 1922 Giuseppe Pedrazzini cello.

## **Dan Padley** is an **electric guitarist**/ **composer** based out of Iowa City, IA.



Since studying music at the University of Iowa, he has performed with many artists, including Wayne Newton, Deb Talan, Elizabeth Moen, River Glen, Dana T, Blake Shaw, comedian Jimmy

Pardo, and many more. Dan has released numerous albums and EPs, including his most recent full length 'Crumbs'. His music combines sounds of jazz, ambience, Americana, and film music. **Blake Shaw,** a versatile musician hailing from Iowa City, is a **double** and electric **bassist**, vocalist, cellist,



**composer/arranger**, and educator who brings a rich tapestry of influences to his craft. In 2010, Blake earned his AA degree from Kirkwood before going on to obtain his BM in Classical Double

Bass Performance in 2013 and his MA in Jazz Composition/Performance in 2017, both from the University of Iowa. You can currently find him teaching in Cedar Rapids as Director of Jazz Studies at the Mount Mercy Campus of St. Ambrose University. In addition to his academic and performance pursuits, Blake actively contributes to the music community as a board member of the Iowa City Jazz Fest and the Entertainment Director for the Iowa City Pride Festival. Blake can be found performing close to every week with a diverse array of bands, ranging from solo acts to big bands.
